The event was so successful that the group decided to continue their efforts and began recruiting operator and oilfield service companies to join them.

OHH raises money through donations, corporate memberships and fundraising events each year to be given based on need to members of the oilfield industry family. OHH is registered in Texas as a nonprofit corporation and as a public charity is exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
